





Valero resumes work on refinery expansion project in Texas

September 2010

Valero Energy Corporation, Texas-based oil and gas company, has resumed work on a major refinery expansion project in Port Arthur, Texas.

The \$1.4 billion project had been postponed by the San Antonio-based independent refiner due to recessionary conditions. The project is likely to be completed and ready for production in 2012.

The \$2.2 billion conversion project at Total Port Arthur refinery is nearing completion and the first of its units is going through initial start-up. The Motiva Enterprises Port Arthur refinery expansion, valued at about \$7.5 billion, is entering its busiest phase with the final delivery of its modules, heaters and pressure vessels. The new unit will be built on 13 acres of refinery property.
